

Class Jeremiah – Autumn 2 - 2022

English

This term we will concentrate on writing text based on *Esio Trot* by Roald Dahl. We will start off by reading the book and identifying key character traits and then go on to write a diary and persuasive letter. This will finally be followed by a class debate.

Maths

As mathematicians, children will embed their addition and subtraction skills this term. They will revisit column method for addition and subtraction using 4-digit numbers and solve word problems. We will then move onto measurements and perimeters and finish the year with multiplication and division.

Science

We are looking at sound this term. This will involve learning about the speed of sound. We will also learn about pitch and volume. Finish the topic with learning about how we hear.

PE

Children will be learning outdoors and enjoying forest school, where they will have the opportunity to build a bird's nest, create mazes and climb trees. Once a week we will also be visited by the Leicester Tigers for Tag rugby and Cricket.

Computing

Children will be learning all about coding, which will include designing algorithms, decomposition and abstraction.

RE

This term for RE we will be looking at why does Christmas matter to Christians and its significance. We will also learn about Diwali, how it is celebrated and what it means to Hindu's.

Art

We will be exploring architecture and in particular 'The Eiffel Tower.' The children will be taught to develop their techniques, including their control and their use of materials, with creativity, experimentation and an increasing awareness of different kinds of art.

History / Geography

In Geography the children will be learning about Western Europe and settlements. In particular we will be comparing Paris and London. History this term is based on the Greek philosophy and Alexander the Great. The children will be learning about the conquest of Greece and Alexander's Empire.

Music

Children will continue to develop their listening skills and use their musical knowledge to learn how to play brass instruments, which include the cornet, p-bone and baritone.

PSHE

The PSHE topic this term is self-care. We will be looking at using our 'Discoverer' skills to understand what a balanced diet. Our 'Notice' skills to distinguish between situations that may involve risks, hazards and dangers and those that may not. Our 'Advisors' skilfully to navigate potentially hazardous situations, including the use of community safety skills. Finally, our 'value' skills to guide us towards positive self-care.
