Dear Parent/Carer

Welcome back to the new year at All Saints! Let's hope and pray that 2023 will find us safe, well and healthy. Staff have been busy planning for the remainder of the academic year and these are already well under way. I hope your child will enjoy the remainder of the academic year and make the most of the many opportunities on offer. Please do continue to support your child in their learning by completing weekly homework, by practicing spellings, times tables and reading EVERY DAY with your child. It really is vital to their success as we as teachers can only do so much.

## Uniform

When purchasing new school wear please remember that the children **must wear** correct uniform at all times and we will be monitoring it closely for the remainder of this year. The school uniform consists of:

- Pale blue or white polo shirts, and grey trousers, skirts or pinafores with a royal blue sweatshirt or cardigan (these can be bought with the school's logo printed on them from Trinity School Wear and plain from local supermarkets).
- A blue and white checked cotton dress can also be worn in the warmer months .
- Sensible, flat, black shoes should be worn for school, trainers are allowed providing they are solid black. Ankle black boots are acceptable during the winter months. If your child wears wellingtons in wet weather, please ensure they bring their shoes to change into at school.
- P.E. kit should be a blue or white plain t-shirt, plain jogging bottoms or shorts in navy, black or dark grey, a sweatshirt and trainers. P.E. kit is to be worn for Forest School along with sturdy shoes/wellingtons
- Plimsolls/indoor trainers will be required during the winter months for indoor PE.

As too many children are still not wearing school uniform, if your child is in incorrect uniform staff will be in contact with you to support you in this if needed. In particular please remember that we do have a PE uniform: it is not appropriate to send your child in play clothes for PE. Our lovely new hoodies are perfect for Forest School and outdoor PE. Please do not send your child in 'branded' sportswear; purchase the uniform instead.

You are able to purchase uniform with the school's logo through Trinity School Wear either direct at [www.trinityschoolwear.co.uk](http://www.trinityschoolwear.co.uk) or via ParentPay.

In the interests of safety jewellery should not be worn at any time, apart from one pair of plain studs, at your own risk. All children with pierced ears should ensure that studs are covered with microporous tape, supplied from home, during P.E. lessons. Nail varnish is also not permitted.

Please ensure that your child has an appropriate hairstyle for when they come to school. Very long hair must be tied back for safety. During P.E. long hair must be securely tied back and watches must be removed.

It should be noted that school staff cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage to children's personal belongings although they will do their best to ensure that children behave responsibly. **It is essential that all items of clothing, including P.E. kit are clearly marked with your child's name please**
