PE and Forest School

Reading

Each child can change their book on Fridays. It is vitally important and expected that **children read at home for 15-20 minutes every day**. It is expected that children read to and/or discuss their book with an adult at home. This should be recorded with a signature and a comment in their reading journal and on their reading rocket. Speaking to your child about what they have read, enjoyed or disliked about a book will help deepen their understanding, widen their vocabulary and improve their writing. We need your support to continue to help all children to make fantastic progress and feel confident and successful.

Homework

Homework will be sent home on Fridays. **Please return on Wednesdays**. There will be spellings to practise and MyMaths tasks online. This is in addition to daily reading. Creative topic-based projects will also be set during the term. Please practise reading and spelling the Year 1 and 2 common exception words in the front of your homework book. If you can learn all of these words, it will help you to read speedily.
