


English

As authors, children will work on orally retelling and then writing their own setting descriptions inspired by Hansel and Gretel written by Jane Ray. Children will focus on using description, structuring sentences correctly and spelling words with suffixes such as -er, -est, -ed and -ing. We will also write instructions for how to make a gingerbread house and explore poetry linked to George's Marvellous Medicine.



Maths

In maths, children in Year 1 will concentrate on counting, ordering, reading and writing numbers up to 20 and learn about shape. Everyone will focus on addition and subtraction and Year 2 children will apply their knowledge of addition or subtraction to working with money. They will also begin to develop their understanding of multiplication and division.

Science

As scientists the children will learn how to make and represent electrical circuits. We will discuss different types of energy and why saving electricity is important. We will also be learning about how to stay safe around electricity and identifying materials that are conductive and non-conductive.

PE

In PE, the children will be working independently and with a partner to create and link movements as part of our dance unit. They will be exploring making different shapes with their bodies and comparing their movements and skills to others. Children will create movements to fit a theme and develop their own rules.

Through the story '*El muñequito de jengibre*' (The gingerbread man), the children will learn numbers to 10, farm animals and explore the concept of masculine and feminine words.


RE

Our topic is 'What does it mean to belong to a faith community?'. The children will learn about the importance of belonging and how different faiths show they belong and celebrate life events such as marriage and baptisms. Children will celebrate Christmas and learn about the Christmas story.

Art

As designers, children will design and make their own wands based on design criteria, before evaluating their product.

They will make functional and appealing Christmas cards and complete artwork inspired by our whole school story, Hansel and Gretel. The children will explore collaging techniques, layering and pattern and make their own paper.



History

As part of our 'Discovering History' unit, children will answer questions such as 'What is the past?' and 'What do we know about history?'. Children will explore family trees and learn about what an archaeologist does. Children will complete a historical study about Mary Seacole and develop their understanding of the past and present.



Music

Children will continue to develop their understanding of tempo, pitch and rhythm using the Charanga unit: Ho, ho, ho! Children will explore elements of performance and add movement to words in songs, including learning a signed version of Ho, ho, ho!

PSHE

We will be focusing on how to look after ourselves and different aspects of self-care. They will also learn about how to stay safe on Bonfire night and around medicine. We will learn about stranger danger and take part in anti-bullying week.
