- Visit your local library or look online and see if you can find any books about bodies. Can you compare human and animal bodies?
- Write a body quiz to share with your class.
- Design and make a maths game inspired by the book series Funnybones.
- Learn a song or poem about your body and teach it to your friends. Can you add any actions?
- Use a computer to draw a picture of a body part or a skeleton.
- Design and create a brand new animal. What is different about it? You could use Lego, junk modelling or your own fantastic ideas.
- Look on the internet at home or at the library with a grown up to find and record some facts about your body. Present them in your own way.
- Find and read a story inspired by bodies. Share a review of your story with your class.
- Test your senses and tell your class all about it. How many different sounds did you hear on the way to school? Did you taste anything new?
