Year 1 and 2 - Magic



This half term's topic is 'Magic. We will be exploring optical illusions and electricity. We will be designing and making wands and linking our topic to the story of Hansel and Gretel.

Your homework project is your opportunity to do your own learning linked to this topic in a way that interests you. We would love you to be as creative as possible to show us what you found out.

Here are some ideas:

- Design and make your own magic box. What would it look like? What would you find inside?
- Visit your local library and see if you can find any books about magic or any stories about magical characters.
- Read an alternative version of Hansel and Gretel and write a book review for your friends.
- Look online with a grown up and try to find out about magic tricks or optical illusions.
- Learn and perform a magic trick. Can you teach your friends the trick too?
- Create a potion and write down the recipe. What is your potion for?
- Learn and perform a poem about magic. You could even write your own poem.
- Carefully draw your own magical character and write a description about them. Why are they so special?
